Paw Paw's Dog House Rules and Regulations

To insure the safety and health of all dogs and staff at Paw Paw's Dog House, we require all clients to comply with the following Rules and Regulations:

SEX: All dogs must be spayed or neutered (unless under 10 months of age)

SHOTS: All dogs under 2 years of age must be current on all vaccinations. We do accept Titer test results in place of vaccinations. Dogs that are regularly socialized and exposed to others and over the age of 2 need only to show proof of current rabies vaccination. Standard shot requirements are Distemper, Parvovirus, Rabies, Bordatella. Owner must provide a receipt showing dates shots obtained. It is your responsibility to provide on-going verification of current vaccinations.

HEALTH: All dogs must be in good health. Parents will need to certify that their dogs are in good health and have been free from conditions that could potentially jeopardize other guest. Paw Paw's Dog House must be notified if your dog becomes ill with a communicable condition. Dog who have been ill with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require veterinarian certification of health to be readmitted. If, at any time during care, a dog is noticed to have fleas or ticks, treatment will be applied and charged to the parent. Paw Paw's Dog House requires a flea and parasite preventative, excluding flea/ tick collars.

FOOD: All dog food and snacks brought to Paw Paw's Dog House must be stored in an airtight container. Boarders must supply their own food for the duration of stay. Please feed your dog at least 1 hour prior to daycare so that there is time to digest food.

BEHAVIOR: All dogs must pass the Paw Paw's Dog House behavior assessment for enrollment to our program. All dogs must be non-aggressive toward dogs or people and be non-possessive over toys or food. Parents will need to certify that their dog has not harmed or shown aggressive or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dogs. Please remember that your pet will be spending time with other pets and that their safety and health is our main priority. Keep in mind, although it is supervised play, your dog still might acquire an occasional nip or scratch.

DAMAGES: Parents are responsible for all damages done to the facility by ones dog. Including chewing, digging, pulling to crates, enclosures, structure inside and out, furniture, yard and fencing.

AGE: Any age dog/ puppy is allowed at Paw Paw's Dog House as long as the dog/puppy meets the Paw Paw's Dog House criteria. Puppies may begin Paw Paw's Dog House before they receive their

Rabies vaccine and before they are spayed and neutered as long as both will be taken care of by 6 months of age.

ENROLLMENT: All dogs must complete, up-to-date, and approved enrollment form on file and commit to one day every 6 months to be considered a regular/ established Paw Paw's dog. If the commitment is not met, your dog may be required to under-go a re-assessment and additional fees may apply. If your dog has been out of daycare for more than 2 month, re-assessment is required. ALL PAW PAW'S DOG HOUSE FORMS MUST BE SIGNED BY PARENT BEFORE ENROLLMENT.

FEES: Daycare fees are due payable at the end of each day. Advanced payment is encouraged since it will speed up the end of day pick-up. Cash, check or credit cards are accepted. Current fees are available in our office and published on our website. Any veterinary fees incurred as a result of daycare participation are the responsibility of the parent.

HOURS OF OPERATION: Monday through Friday from 7am to 6pm. Drop off hours are 7-9am and pick up hours are 4-6pm Special times may be arranged. Pick up and drop offs for boarders may be made on the weekends. Paw Paw's Dog House closes promptly at 6pm. Late charges may be applied.

RESERVATIONS: Required. Cancellations not made by 6pm one business day prior to the scheduled day care day will be charged full fees and invoiced to the parent.

Client Agreement/Liability Waiver

For myself, my heirs, and any assigns, I hereby release Paw Paw's Dog House, it's members, employees, subcontractors, animal parents, customers and potential customers of Paw Paw's Dog House from any and all liabilities for injuries to myself, my dog, or any other property of mine which arise in any way out of service and/ or products provided by or as a consequence of my association with Paw Paw's Dog House.

I acknowledge and understand that every dog reacts differently and that animals, by nature are unpredictable. Dogs may, without warning, bite or cause injury to humans and other dogs. I acknowledge and understand that there is a certain risks involved in participating in doggy daycare, including but not limited to dogfights, dog bites to humans or other dogs, and transmission of disease. In case of emergency, I recognize the risks of injury that accompany emergency transport and acknowledge that this RELEASE is being relied upon by Paw Paw's Dog House to permit transportation of my dog to and from Paw Paw's Dog House or any other necessary location. Furthermore, I accept any and all conditions, rules and regulations defined by Paw Paw's Dog House associated with the activities, use of the facilities and transport, and hereby agree to comply with them. I grant Paw Paw's Dog House and/or its selected agent's full power of decision concerning the care and well-being of my dog. Should any medical emergency arise, it is agreed that Paw Paw's Dog House or its selected agents can and will make any needed decision concerning medical treatment and choice of care giver which I will be responsible for payment of.
